While Matthew (Matt) Oxendine sat inside his car at his residence on January 9, 2021, he was killed by law enforcement in a violent hail of bullets. According to the medical examiner, Robeson County Sheriff's deputies used both high-powered rifles and handguns to shoot Matt 30 times, blowing a large hole on the left side of his face, shattering his shoulder blade, tearing off most of his left arm and lodging numerous bullets in his spine.

No one has been held accountable for this gruesome and unnecessary use of force that killed a 46-year-old Native American man who needed trained mental health counselors, not deputies ready to aim and fire.

The Protest will take place at Biggs Park Mall in Lumberton North Carolina on February 5th. They will begin gathering around 12pm and begin marching at 1pm.
